

LEAD EXPOSURE SCREENING AND TREATMENT PROVIDER EDUCATION

Texas law (Tex. Health & Safety Code Chapter 88 and 25 Tex. Admin. Code Chapter 37, Subchapter Q) requires that **all** blood lead test results for children 14 years and younger be reported to the state's 24/7 electronic system.

Texas HHSC provides a short course covers what providers need to know to screen, test, and retest children; properly collect blood specimens; use the mandatory reporting system; and protect Texas children from being exposed to lead in the first place.
